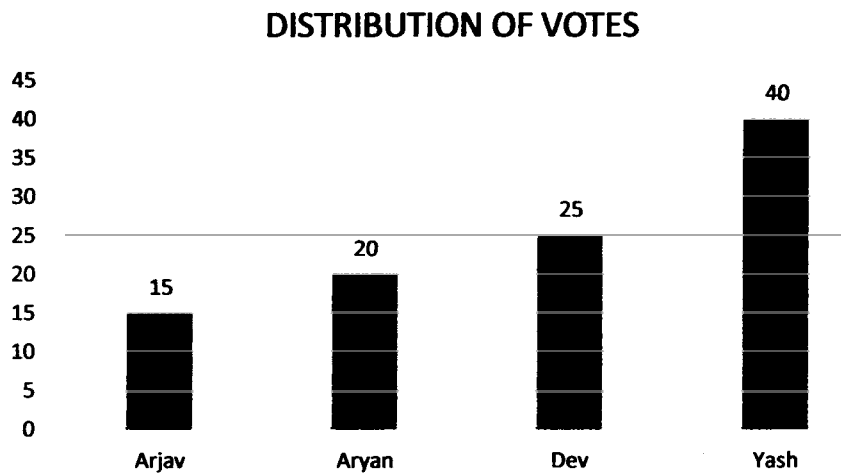

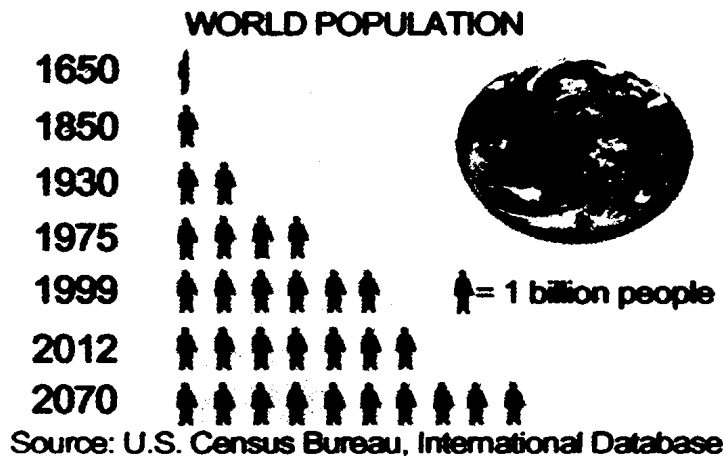
What picture of Mother Teresa do you get from the lesson?
